Our goal at the Cultural Services of the French Embassy in the United States is to strengthen relationships and collaborations between French and U.S. higher education institutions (HEIs) by promoting mutual understanding.

Participating in the Community College in France program gives administrators and faculty the opportunity to familiarize themselves with the French higher education system, connect with French counterparts in the host institution or other institutions in the area, and gain innovative ideas to implement upon their return. Hence, the idea is not for administrators or faculty to act as chaperones for the students but to be proactive and engaging actors. Ultimately, we want the Bootcamps to facilitate the creation of new collaborations between Community Colleges and French institutions.

Faculty, administrators, and international education professionals are all eligible to apply. We only require that they are currently employed in a U.S. Community College.

The **Bootcamps** primarily opportunity are an for students. Administrators and faculty are accepted on a limited, space-available basis. Priority will be given to those who clearly demonstrate how they can be Community College an asset to their in pursuing new partnerships.





PROGRAM COST

The participation cost is \$1,000.

Are included: accommodation, meals, visits/activities, airport pick-up and drop-off, and local public transportation.

Plane tickets to and from France are not included.

HOW TO APPLY

Community college faculty and administrators interested in joining one of the Bootcamps should apply using the **online application form.**

 "Science for a Sustainable Development: from Conservation of Natural Heritage to Future Society" at Université de Lille (June 30 - July 13)

 "Beyond the Postcard: Nature, Culture and Sustainability in the French Caribbean" at Université des Antilles (July 1 - July 14)

Candidates will also be asked to upload a resume with their online application.
