#### **PROGRAM COST**

The program cost amounts to \$2,400. It includes: accommodation, meals, visits and activities, airport pick-up and drop-off, and local public transportation. Plane tickets to and from France are not included.

The French Embassy offers \$1,400 scholarships to lower the participation cost to \$1,000.
