Summary

COC Global: A Taskforce on Comprehensive Internationalization was formed in November 2016 as an initiative by the Office of International Services and Programs (ISP) at College of the Canyons (COC). The task force has been developing comprehensive educational experiences emphasizing global awareness, responsibility, and participation.

COC Global, with the help of ISP, has participated in and organized several globally-focused events. Event participants included students, staff, faculty, administrators, volunteers, and the broader Santa Clarita community. We are excited about bringing such a wide variety of globally focused events to COC.

Event Descriptions

In the Spring 2024 semester, for the second year in a row, we put together the International Animation Festival (IAF), a gathering featuring aspiring young student animators. The festival was held on Saturday, March 16^{th,} and highlights young artists looking to continue learning their craft and building a community. Specifically, we look for aspiring animators who are community college, high school, international, and four-year university students. This festival is also looking to break ground as a showcase for films centered around student causes. For the 2024 event, we were especially interested in animated films exploring the topic of Climate Change and Contemporary Social Media Issues. We wanted to showcase these often-underrepresented students to allow them to present their films for awards and recognition. With no submission fee, this was a great opportunity for first-time animators to exhibit their work.

In addition to showcasing students' work, we seek professionals to present and sit on panel discussions. This year, a representative from Sony Picture Animation gave pointers on students' portfolios and how to get a job in the animation Industry. Additionally, we had a panel discussion on Identity in Animation, which explores ethnic, social, and gender roles within the animation industry.

We are happy to report that in our second year, we saw an increase in film submissions and attendance from the first year.
