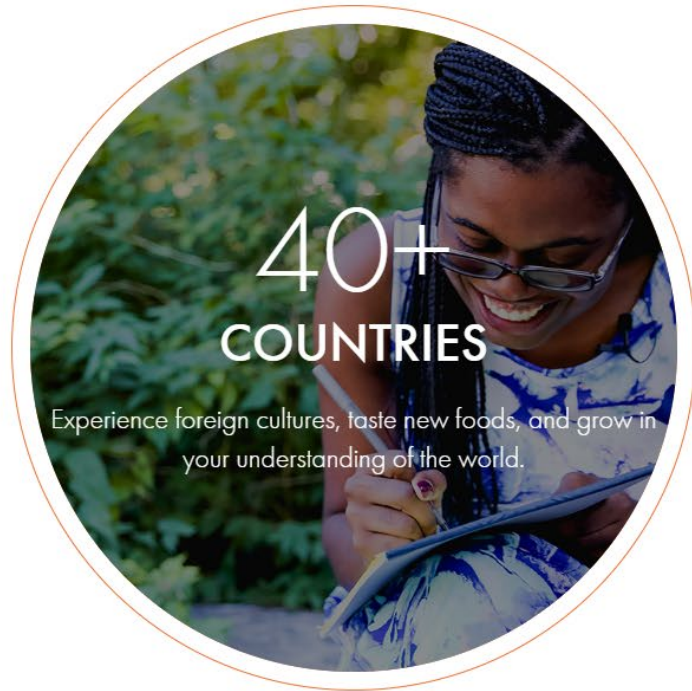
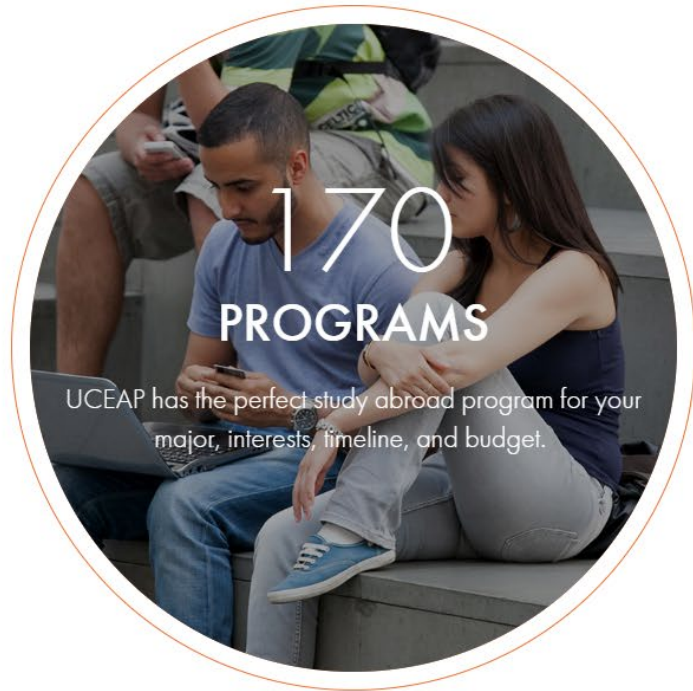

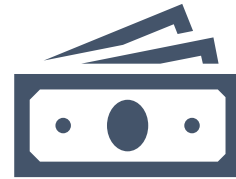
General Overview



UCEAP is a self-supporting academic program funded entirely from student fees.



Students participating with UCEAP continue to pay their standard UC tuition and fees, which UCEAP retains net of return-to-aid. UCEAP also charges its own UCEAP specific fees.



The net student fee revenue that UCEAP collects funds:

- The UCEAP Systemwide Office
- The International Study Center Offices
- Host Institution Program Fees
- Campus EAP Office Cost Sharing

Host Institution Tuition Fees



Students participating with UCEAP continue to pay their standard UC tuition and fees.



Tuition charged by the partner institution is paid by UCEAP from the available UC and UCEAP fee revenue collected from the students.



Payments to the host institution are made in the local currency and are variable depending on enrollment and the exchange rate.
